

## Iridium 9555 Quick Guide

### **Making a Test Call**

- 1. Make sure you are **outside** with an open view of the sky, away from any obstructions.
- 2. Once outside, fully extend the antenna. Hold the on/ off button for **5sec**. Make sure the antenna is straight at all times.
- 3. Once the phone says registered, hold the "O" key until the "+" symbol appears, then dial country code (Canada/US are "1") & number.
- 4. Press the green button to place the call, and the red button to end the call.

## **Your Iridium**

### Sending a Text Message from the **Iridium Phone**

- 1. Ensure you are **outside** and have a clear view of the sky.
- 2. Press Menu
- 3. Using the arrow keys, scroll to **Messages** and press Select.
- 4. Create Message should be highlighted, press Select.
- 5. Enter your message and press Options.
- 6. Follow the on-screen prompts to send text message.

#### Calling to a Landline or Cellphone

- 1. Hold the "O" key until the "+" symbol appears, then dial Country Code, and rest of phone number.
- 2. Press green button. (talk)
- 3. Press red button to end.

#### Calling another Iriduim phone

1. Dial 8816 - XXXX - XXXX

#### Receiving calls on your phone

- 1. Caller first dials: 1-480-768-2500
- 2. When prompted enter the Iridium phone number. (below)
- 3. Wait to be connected.

- 1. Have the person go to: messaging.iridium.com
- 2. In the form, enter the 12 digit sat phone number without any dashes.
- 3. Enter a reply email and your message.
- 4. Solve the CAPTCHA
- 5. Click Send Message.

#### **Checking your Voicemail**

- 1. Press the **menu** key.
- 2. Scroll down to Voicemail.
- 3. Hit **select** to call Voicemail.
- 4. When you hear the greeting, immediately press the \* on keypad.
- 5. When prompted for a password, enter "9999" or the last seven (7) digits of your Iridium Phone Number.



Use your Iridium phone with the antenna extended in an open area where the antenna has an unobstructed 360° view of the sky.



**Avoid** using your Iridium phone near large buildings, trees or mountains as these can obstruct line of sight with the satellites.
